History of the Rebel Corps

This organization we know as the Georgia Jaycee Rebel Corps had its founding moments back in 1956. At this time there was a small group of past state Jaycee officers ("has beens") that would always gather together at each board meeting and state convention, since they never missed one, to reminisce and socialize. These Jaycees decided to give their group the title "**ROYAL ORDER OF KNIGHTS REMINISCENT**". They even designed a business card, which showed a fist held in a horizontal position with the forefinger extended and pointing down at a crooked angle.

This group's only functions were to socialize, reminisce, and play politics. Their "meetings" would generally end up as all night discussions. At their height, the Royal Order of Knight Reminiscent had about 15 members.

State President Abit Massey, 1956-57, and James Fullin, while coming back from a visitation to the Canton Jaycees, began discussing the idea of an organization to recognize and honor outstanding Jaycees from the local chapters.

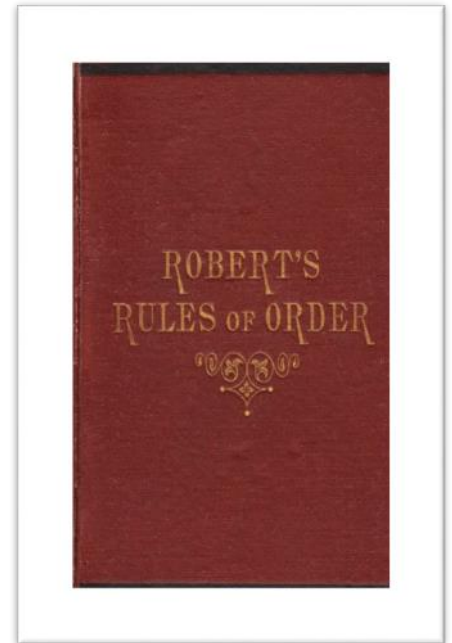

History concluded

As State President Abit determined that the Royal Order of Knights Reminiscent had become too political and met with them to discuss the total abandonment of this "social" group. He explained the idea he and James Pullin had and the Knights agreed to disband.

During the Jaycee year of 1957-58, much discussion was held concerning this new group to be formed. Who were to be the charter members, what policies and by-laws would govern this group, when and where would they meet? Abit Massey is credited with being the founding father and giving this organization the name **REBEL CORPS**.

The Georgia Jaycee Rebel Corps was officially founded at the State Convention on May 17, 1958 at St. Simons Island. The first officers were: Abit Massey, Commander; Richard Thornton & Peter Rhyne, Vice-Commanders; Phil Dohn, Adjutant; and Jack McGinty, Treasurer. Richard Thornton served as our second Commander and co-planner of the Rebel Corps, James Pullin was our third Commander.

History of the Corps Patch

The idea for the patch and pin came from the mind of Commander Massey. In those days, the Georgia Jaycees had a close working relationship with the Nevada Jaycees. Each year, we would have a joint party with them at the National Convention. Many of the Nevada Jaycees wanted to wear the Rebel Corps patch on their uniforms. From this idea of giving patches to the Nevada Jaycees helped spread the reputation of the Rebels Corps to other states.

We now give out patches, pins, shirts and all sorts of Georgia memorabilia to show the we aren't only the first Corps but to remind everyone we are the best!

How the cocktail party started.....

The first few years of the Rebel Corps the membership was small but continued to grow in prestige due to the fact that the requirements for membership were strict and only individuals that had performed outstanding service to the State Jaycee Organization were accepted.

The idea for the Cocktail Party was thought of just a few years after our founding. The Hospitality Room has been with us from the beginning. During the 1968-69 Jaycee year the Rebel Corps voted to give Honorary Membership to outstanding Jaycees from other states that visited Georgia. However, much of the by-laws and policies of the Corps that we have today have remained almost unchanged from the beginning.

The Corps continues to be an honor that is bestowed on not just anyone. You must have lived the creed and done the work of all the Jaycees before you. The cocktail party has become the time for all of us to get together and hash out differences, relive memories and shed a tear from time to time as we remember those that have gone too soon. This to some may just be a party but to those of us that have lived as embodied in the Jaycee and Corps creed this is our time to come together and know our years of hard work and friendship have all been worth it.

This Jekyll please raise a glass and send cheers to all the worthy Colonels and Commanders before us and all the Jaycees in the ranks to become us.

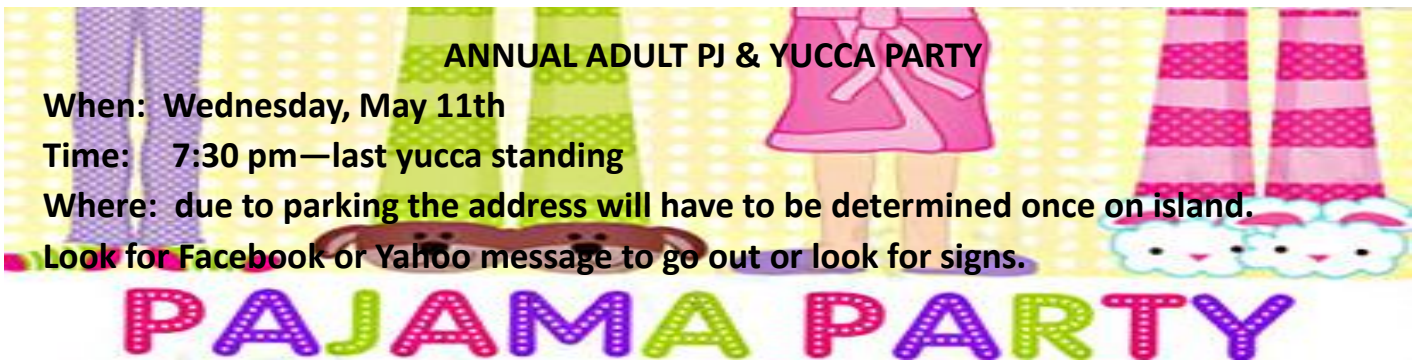

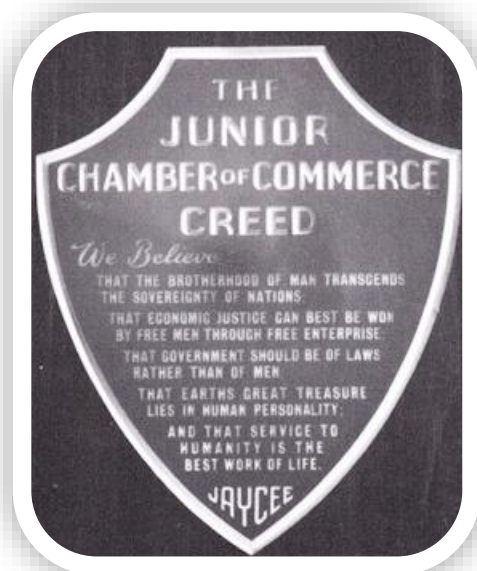
