They even designed a business card, which showed a fist held in a horizontal position with the forefinger extended and pointing down at a crooked

This group's only functions were to socialize, reminisce, and play politics. Their "meetings" would generally end up as all night discussions. At their height, the Royal Order of Knight Reminiscent had about 15 members.



As State President Abit determined that the Royal Order of Knights Reminiscent had become too political and met with them to discuss the total abandonment of this "social" group. He explained the idea he and James Pullin had and the Knights agreed to disband.

During the Jaycee year of 1957-58, much discussion was held concerning this new group to be formed. Who were to be the charter members, what policies and by-laws would govern this group, when and where would they meet? Abit Massey is credited with being the founding father and giving this organization the name <u>REBEL CORPS</u>.

The Georgia Jaycee Rebel Corps was officially founded at the State Convention on May 17, 1958 at St. Simons Island. The first officers were: Abit Massey, Commander; Richard Thornton & Peter Rhyne, Vice-Commanders; Phil Dohn, Adjutant; and Jack McGinty, Treasurer. Richard Thornton served as our second Commander and coplanner of the Rebel Corps, James Pullin was our third Commander.

Proposed Bylaw changes.... Please see proposed bylaw changes below that came from the last Long Range Planning Committee and will be voted on in Columbus at the business meeting.....

Article III, Section 2

All Nominations must be made by a Colonel in good standing and the application approved by either, the current local President (except in case of outgoing President) and one other chapter officer, or the Commander and one Past Commander. (See Policy Manual)

Article VI, Section 3

The officers of the Rebel Corps shall be nominated at a special called Rebel Corps meeting to be held within 45 days after July 1, at a time and location set by the Commander. The elections will be held at the Corps' second Trimester meeting at a time and location set by the Commander. Officers will be sworn in at the Third Trimester meeting at a time and location set by the Commander. No announcements or nominations shall take place prior to July 1.






