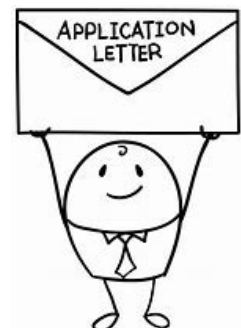

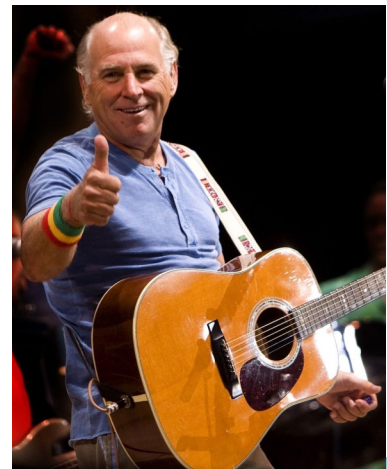


make it work for me. If I can do it, then so can you! And if I say something to you at the door then please understand I'm not a D**k. I'm just doing my job :-)

Happy July! We have had a busy couple of months around the State!

In April, three Georgia Jaycees along with State Board Advisor Trent Sanford made the trip to Myrtle Beach for the National Convention. This year was the first year the Georgia Jaycees have been present at National Convention in at least six years. We were able to participate in training courses, awards ceremonies, and meet fellow Jaycees from around the nation.

The Athens Jaycees did an amazing job of hosting the Athens Twilight Bike Race on April 28th. Thousands of people poured into downtown Athens to witness some of the best bikers around ride circles around the city. I can't say enough good about this event in regards to tourism and spirit for Athens. PLEASE consider volunteering at this event next year. The Athens Jaycees rely on volunteers throughout the week for set-up and on the day of for a successful event and they had to utilize some of the proceeds to pay people to work the event due to low volunteer numbers this year.

Two weeks later, Jaycees from the Milledgeville, Athens and Statesboro chapters scooted down to Jekyll Island to spend a fantastic weekend with all of you! We are so grateful for the hospitality you all showed us and can't wait to get back down there next year with more chapters.

During May, the Dahlonega Jaycees gave three \$1000 scholarships to students in their community and Swainsboro held their annual Pine Tree Festival successfully. JCI Atlanta hosted JCI Peace is Possible speaker Ashlea Elliott for their first Keynote Speaker of the year on May 29th and had a great turnout. The Jesup Jaycees held their first Spring Fair successfully in May as well. In June, the Savannah and Statesboro Jaycees went bananas together on June 29th at a Savannah Bananas home game. On the 30th, the Milledgeville Jaycees hosted a Camp Dream Camp Out and had over 200 in attendance. And lastly, July began with a bang down in Swainsboro as the Swainsboro Jaycees celebrated Independence Day by sponsoring their annual community fireworks display on the 4th!

As we look forward to the next few months, we have more work to do. July 14th, the Milledgeville Jaycees will host the 4th annual Splash and Dash river float and the Columbus Jaycees will host their Inaugural Golf Tournament, which will be their first event as a chapter. The Statesboro Jaycees will have their biannual Jaycees Nite Out on August 2nd with a Saturday Night Live theme. All proceeds from that event will go to the Teal House Sexual Assault and Child Advocacy Center.

As a final update, the State Board has decided to follow the advice of a few donors regarding the Walk Across Georgia. Instead of the walk, donors suggested that we have a large Gala that they would be able to attend. We are in the process of scheduling that event in September but seating will be limited to donors. As soon as we have details on the seating and table prices, we will share them with the group. Proceeds from the event will be used to help organizations that deal directly with human trafficking in the State of Georgia as we prepare to host the Super Bowl in 2019.

Thank you for your continued support and wisdom. We look forward to ending 2018 in true Jaycees spirit!

Georgia Jaycee Honor Corps Membership Requirements and Rules for Nomination

The Nominee must meet the following Requirements in order to be considered for Membership in the Georgia Jaycee Honor Corps:

1. The requirements for membership are that the **individual must have rendered outstanding contributions to the Jaycees; AND**
 2. If a **Regular Member** or **Exhausted Rooster**, nominee must have been a member of the Georgia Jaycees for at least three years.
{ Article III, Section 1 }
-

Rules for Nomination:

1. Nominations must be made by a **Colonel in good standing** (current on dues) whose signature must appear on the front of the application.
{ Article III, Section 2 & Article V, Section 1 }
2. The application must be **filled out completely.**
3. Each application must be accompanied by a **check in the amount of \$150.00, payable to the Georgia Jaycee Honor Corps.** This fee will be refunded if for any reason the application is not accepted/approved.
4. Nominees should not be notified in advance of the approval of the pending application. Approval is not automatic.
{ Article IV, Section 4 }
5. Applications not submitted in the following manner will not be considered:
 - All applications should be submitted to the Region Screening Committee Chairman;
OR
 - If there is no Region Screening Committee Chairman, then submit the application and fee to the current Inactive Vice-Commander.
